Structured Learning Centers provide small group learning opportunities for students with behavioral (SLC-B's) or cognitive processing difficulties (SLC-A's). SLC teachers focus on meeting the unique needs of the students through direct instruction with a small group of students. Students are given the opportunity to mainstream with their peer group. There are SLCA and SLC-B programs for the grade levels K-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12 and post high. The students' IEP team has the responsibility to determine if placement in a SLC classroom is the least restrictive environment for the student.
