## **Our new 21st century Sandy High School will be completed by fall 2012**

### ***NEW HIGH SCHOOL HIGHLIGHTS***

- ◆ Located on Bell Street in Sandy, the school will be built into the natural landscape of the 82 acre forested property.
- ◆ The new school will be 310,000 square feet, as compared to the current school's 160,000 square feet.
- ◆ The campus will accommodate a minimum 1,600 students with support space for an additional 200.
- ◆ The new library, with extended learning areas, will be nearly three times larger than the current library.
- ◆ Fully equipped science labs will accommodate more lab experiences.
- ◆ The environmental area, including ponds, trails, and wildlife, will accommodate outdoor learning experiences.
- ◆ Updated athletics facilities include seating for 1800 in the main gymnasium, and an indoor track.
- ◆ A Performing Arts Center includes stadium seating for about 500 people, and an orchestra pit.

#### ***A healthy school for students and staff:***

The new school is designed to be energy and cost efficient and will accommodate countless opportunities for learning about environmental sustainability. Features include clerestories above the gymnasium to provide natural lighting, a displacement air system for improved air quality, an underground cistern to capture rain water for non-potable use, and green roofs.

#### ***Wired for 21st century learning:***

The new school will be wired to keep up with ever-changing technology. It will be fully wireless, will accommodate student hand-held learning devices, and will have a guest network for parents to access – similar to a wireless café.

#### ***Career & Technical education options:***

The Career & Technical Education (CTE) Department will include agriculture, manufacturing, automotive technology, engineering drafting, and construction management programs. With the updated facility we will be better able to align with industry standards.
