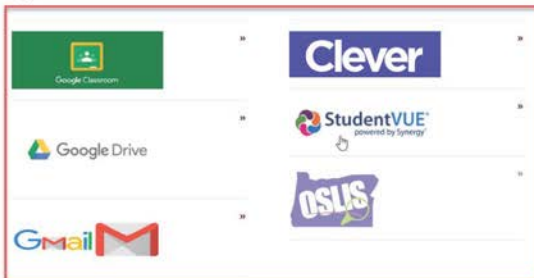
Go to www.oregontrailsschools.com and click *Students*.



Students can access curriculum in two ways.

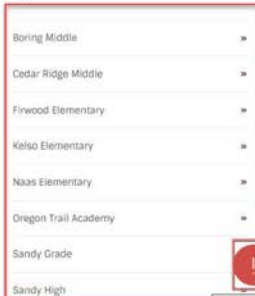
1. By clicking on the icon of the program they wish to access
