UPDATE: Governor orders Oregonians to ‘Stay Home, Save Lives’

Governor Brown issued an executive order today, stating: ‘It is essential to the health, safety, and welfare of the State of Oregon during the ongoing state of emergency that, to the maximum extent possible, individuals stay at home or at their place of residence, consistent with the directives set forth in my Executive Orders and guidance issued by the Oregon Health Authority.’

The order includes the immediate closure of ‘all pools, skate parks, outdoor sports courts, and playground equipment areas.’ In response, all OTSD campuses including playgrounds, ball fields, and courts will be closed until further notice.
