Increasing student in-person learning

Hybrid Instruction is now occurring at all grade levels, K-12, across the district!



We are excited to announce our transition for elementary students to 4 days per week of in-person classroom instruction. Our A & B Cohorts will merge, and those students who are currently participating in In-Person Instruction will be able to attend in-person classes on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. The daily 4-hour schedule will remain as is. Families who selected to stay in Comprehensive Distance Learning will continue to do so.

The transition to 4-days will begin on April 15 for grades K-2 and April 19 for grades 3-5.

We will share information regarding a transition to 4 in-person days for middle and high school students soon.

We must all remain vigilant

We have a robust system in place to address your child's health and safety, and we believe we are equipped to accommodate the new 3-foot physical distance allowance. However, 6 feet continues to be the threshold of close contact for exposure determination by public health, even when 3 feet of physical distance is permitted. Therefore, we need families to remain vigilant about [screening](#) their child(ren) for symptoms of COVID-19 before they leave for school each morning. If a classroom of students is exposed to one symptomatic student, it is possible the entire class would need to quarantine for ten days.
