Increasing in-person learning at middle schools

As of April 19, all students in grades K-5 Hybrid Learning will have transitioned to 4 days per week of in-person classroom instruction. It's exciting to see so many students back together in our classrooms!



We're now happy to announce that middle school students, grades 6-8, will transition to 4 days – Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday - effective Thursday, April 22. The 4-hour daily schedule will remain as is. Families who selected to stay in Comprehensive Distance Learning will continue to do so.

We will share information regarding a transition to 4 in-person days for high school students soon.

Please remain vigilant

We have a robust system in place to address your child's health and safety, and we believe we are equipped to accommodate the new 3-foot physical distance allowance. However, 6 feet continues to be the threshold of close contact for exposure determination by public health, even when 3 feet of physical distance is permitted. Therefore, we need families to remain vigilant about screening their child(ren) for symptoms of COVID-19 before they leave for school each morning. If a classroom of students is exposed to one symptomatic student, it is possible the entire class would need to quarantine for ten days.
