Updated Mask Guidance

Good morning,

In light of the guidance recently released by the Oregon Health Authority (OHA), we want to reaffirm that students and staff must continue to wear masks while in attendance at school despite their vaccination status.

There is good news regarding the recently released guidance as it relates to sports. We will attend to the following guidelines:

Outdoor School Sports

As per the current OHA guidelines, the Oregon Trail School District (OTSD) will not require students, staff, and spectators to wear face coverings at outdoor sporting events. Previous physical distancing and overall capacity restrictions still apply.

Indoor School Sports

As per the current OHA guidelines, OTSD will permit fully vaccinated students, staff, and spectators not to wear masks based on OHA's validation process. Previous physical distancing and overall capacity restrictions still apply.

In accordance with OHA, if fully vaccinated attendees would prefer not to wear masks, they will be required to provide photo identification and a digital or hard copy of proof of vaccination upon entry to each event.

Outdoor Youth Sports on School Property

As per the current OHA guidelines, OTSD will not require students, staff, and spectators to wear face coverings at outdoor sporting events. Previous physical distancing and overall capacity restrictions still apply.

Indoor Youth Sports on School Property

OTSD is unable to accept requests for indoor facility use at this time.
