

# Reopening our Schools: Health Protocols

Supporting health, safety, and shared responsibility

## Bus Transportation

- Drivers and students wear face coverings
- 6 feet physical distance between driver & students
- 1 student per seat; staggered window/aisle to the extent possible
- Siblings sit together
- Passive visual screening for symptoms as students enter bus
- Students exhibiting symptoms seated at the front and given a face mask for added protection, then isolated & monitored at school while waiting for parent pickup
- Buses sanitized between routes

## Arrival & Dismissal

- Parents dropping off students will do so at a designated area at the school
- Separate entrances and exits marked
- Students sanitize or wash hands on entry to and exit from school
- Passive visual screening for symptoms as students enter school/classroom
- Students exhibiting or reporting symptoms isolated & monitored while waiting for parent pickup
- Parents picking up students at the end of the day will either wait in the secure foyer area of the school or their car for their student to be released.

## Health & Hygiene

- Frequent hand sanitizing or washing
- Face coverings required for staff and students
- Schools/classrooms sprayed with disinfectant daily
- Restrooms & common spaces sanitized multiple times during school day
- High school: desks & other classroom touch-points disinfected during transition time between classes

## Physical Distancing & Cohorts

- Strive for 6 feet physical distance between individuals
- 35 square feet per person in classrooms
- Stable cohort/class groups to limit attendance numbers

## Meals

- Breakfast and lunch will not be consumed on site
- Students will pick-up their meal pack as they leave at the end of the school day
- Serving days will vary by school
- Teachers may include snack breaks during their daily routine and will share more information with families
