

# 2021-2022 Health Protocols

Supporting health, safety, and shared responsibility

## Bus Transportation

- Face coverings required for students and drivers
- Passive visual screening for symptoms as students enter the bus
- Seating charts, to the extent possible
- Students exhibiting symptoms seated at the front, then isolated & monitored at school while waiting for parent pickup
- Buses sanitized between routes

## Arrival & Dismissal

- Parents dropping off or picking up students follow specific school instructions
- Separate entrances and exits marked
- Passive visual screening for symptoms as students enter school/classroom
- Students exhibiting or reporting symptoms isolated & monitored while waiting for parent pickup

## Health & Hygiene

- Face coverings required, as mandated by the state
- Access to hand sanitizing or washing throughout the day
- Schools/classrooms cleaned and disinfected regularly
- Restrooms & common spaces cleaned and disinfected regularly
- Effective ventilation & airflow to minimize transmission of airborne pathogens
- Isolation and quarantine protocols, when necessary
- COVID-19 testing for symptomatic students and staff, upon request

## Physical Distancing & Cohorts

- Three feet physical distance between individuals, to the extent possible
- Stable cohorts/classes, to the extent possible

## Meals

- Meals served in school cafeterias or classrooms
